Caddie Qualification Requirements

Eligible caddie candidates will be 14 years old by August 1st and physically capable of carrying a 35 pound golf bag for 18 holes (copy of birth certificate is required for registration).

A \$55 caddie fee is required to purchase caddie uniform.

Evans Scholarship Program

The Evans Foundation Scholarship is a magnificent opportunity and can be worth close to a hundred thousand dollars for a fortunate recipient. It is very wise to begin targeting this opportunity at the beginning of your caddie career and early in high school. Financial need, academic record, caddie record and community service are the four components the scholarship focuses on.
